

Friend of Mine AYMAN

Critically-acclaimed composer Ayman delivers a heart-felt ballad with tender lyrics, colorful instrumentals, and a classic sound in his debut vocal single.

A native of Athens, Georgia, Ayman began composing at five years of age and soon found his passion for it. In 2009, the young musician was discovered by internationally famous artists and thus began a five-year-long World Fusion project between the U.S. and Tunisia. In 2013 he released his debut instrumental album "Embers of Time" hailed by arts critic Andre Gallant as a "triumph of world fusion."

Nearly three years after Embers of Time, the 21-year-old artist has returned to the scene with Friend of Mine, an emotional ballad about saying goodbye. Singing for the first time in a major release, Ayman delivers a powerful vocal performance and tender lyrics that reflect on years of friendship and saying goodbye one last time. Equal parts Sinatra and Sam Smith, this single finds its place comfortably in the realm of popular music while retaining Ayman's timeless signature sound.
